The Greater Cleveland Veterans Memorial, Inc (“GCVM”) announced today that James “Jim” Quisenberry, an original founding member of the organization, has been appointed Vice President. Jim is a decorated combat veteran of the Vietnam War having served with Delta Co., 3rd Battalion, 503rd Infantry, 173rd Airborne Brigade from February 1968 until September when wounds received in action ended his tour of duty. At that time he was a rifle squad leader and held the rank of Sergeant E-5.

The remainder of his enlistment was served as a patient until discharge from Valley Forge Hospital in December 1969. Military awards received include the Bronze Star, Army Commendation Medal w/valor, Purple Heart w/OLC, Air Medal, Vietnam Service and Campaign Medals, Vietnam Cross of Gallantry Unit Citation w/Palm, Combat Infantry Badge, and Parachutist Badge.

Jim retired from his civilian career in 2006 after nearly 32 years with The Illuminating Company and then retired from a second career at First Federal Bank after 10 years in 2018. He is an active member of many veterans’ associations and chapters, including serving as a board member of non-profits Citizens Vision and Equal Honor for All.

Jim resides in Lakewood with his wife Donna. They are blessed with two children: Jim and Angela, son-in-law Rocky, daughter-in-law Jenn, and three grandchildren.
